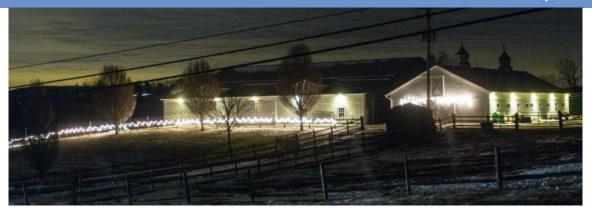
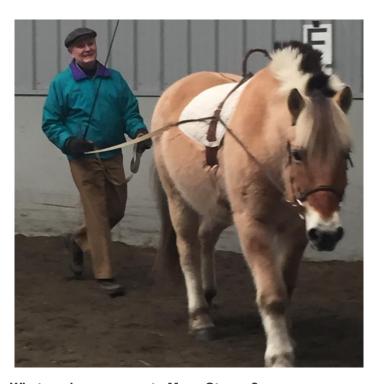

Taylor is a physical therapist who completed her undergraduate studies with a degree in exercise science from the University of Connecticut in 2011 and a Doctorate of Physical Therapy from Rutgers University in 2014. She had internships in a wide variety of clinical settings earning a Certificate in Clinical Excellence in 2014.

When not at Mane Stream, Taylor works as a full time physical therapist in an orthopedic PT clinic and does per diem PT at Morristown Medical Center.

Not only was Taylor a volunteer for years at Mane Stream she has been riding horses since she was a child, riding in junior and adult dedicated to helping out as a long liner with 3 therapy sessions a week along with our Matheny group held each Spring & Fall.

What's the most rewarding part?

Every session for Dan gives him a reason to keep coming back: watching the kids enjoy their time, learn, grow and meet their goals.

Dan's advice for Therapy volunteers:

Volunteers need to learn more about the therapist needs. Because the horses movement is so important, Dan's advice is to ask the Therapist what rhythm and pace is needed for each client. It's more than just walking the horse around the ring. You are part of the therapy team. People who ride, would probably love to long line, as its a similar concept. Dan has been asked to teach and looks forward to leading advanced classes for our volunteers.
